9.30 h Conference. "How do we learn to be women and men? From fairy tales to gender violence".

Mrs. Neus Oliveras Jané, PhD - Universitat Rovira i Virgili.

Abstract: The talk explains how gender stereotypes are built, from childhood to adolescence, and how they are perpetuated in society based on various cultural manifestations, since this social construction is the basis that makes gender violence possible. From here, the notion of gender violence is explained, the erroneous beliefs that persist in this regard are refuted and the possible ways to eradicate this type of violence are reflected on.

Speaker: Ms. Neus Oliveras Jané, Graduated in Law from Universitat de Barcelona (1993) and Doctor in Law from Universitat Rovira i Virgili (2014). She is currently a professor of Constitutional Law at the Faculty of Legal Sciences at the URV. In the field of gender equality, she has been a member of several European projects; in the Epogender project she analyzed the European Protection Order for victims of gender violence, and presented a Report to the European Parliament on the implementation of this norm. The European G-net project created educational materials on European Integration and Gender. She has several publications on the matter, and has given dozens of talks in the Classrooms for the Third Age, to the URV's Antennas of Knowledge, and in institutes and other secondary schools. She has also participated in round tables and has written in the press on gender issues.

12.30 h Conference “Scientific dissemination nowadays” – Mr. Oriol Marimon Garrido, PhD - *Big Van Ciencia*

Abstract: During the talk, the current situation of science dissemination will be discussed, both by the researchers and by the disseminating staff. New approaches, innovative formats, social networks and *Big Van Ciencia* projects will also be discussed. All this will be enlivened with a scientific monologue.

Speaker: Mr. Oriol Marimon Garrido, Doctor in Organic Chemistry from the University of Barcelona in October 2013. His work on bacterial pathogenicity has been published in the journal *Nature Communications*. He is co-founder of *Big Van Ciencia* and Director of International Projects. He continues with social research through his own national and international projects such as H2020-PERFORM. He is the author and actor of popular science plays bringing cutting-edge science to more than 300,000 viewers. He is co-author of several popular science books, such as “Cómo explicar física cuántica con un gato zombi” (Alfaguara Juvenil).

Big Van Ciencia is a non-profit organization for the promotion of culture, education and science through the performing arts. Founded in 2013, its objective is to transform scientific culture into an attractive product for different types of public. “Big Van Ciencia” works to promote science culture and STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) vocations to inspire the next generation of scientists and engineers and strengthen the connection between researchers and the public.
