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BASES FOR THE BEST POSTER

Preamble

The University of Lleida, in its desire to promote research and especially among the younger members of the scientific community, convenes two prizes for the two best posters presented for the DOCTORAL SESSION 2020.

Competition rules

1. Purpose: Award the two best posters presented for the DOCTORAL SESSION 2020.
2. Participants: All communications presented in poster format may be selected for the prizes. The author submitting the poster must be the first author and has to be enrolled in a Doctoral Program at the UdL.
3. The posters have to have next-dimensions: 70cms wide and 100cms high.
4. Budget: Each prize will be awarded with 400€ and a diploma, which will be delivered to the first authors of the work. This amount will be subject to current taxation. In the case that there is more than one first author, the prize will be shared between them.
5. Procedure for prizes selection: A jury formed by the members of the Scientific Committee (base number 9) will select one awarded poster according to the established criteria. The other poster prize will be selected by vote of all the PhD candidates participating in the Welcome Session. In order to be able to vote, the PhD candidates must show an identifying document (DNI or passport in force) when casting their vote.
6. **Criteria: The rigor, the content scientific interest, the presentation, as well as the clarity and capacity for communication will be valued, and the posters follow the following structure: TITLE, INTRODUCTION AND / OR ABSTRACT, OBJECTIVES AND / OR OUTCOMES, CONCLUSIONS.**
7. Decision: The decision of the Jury will be made public at the closing ceremony and will be unappeasable. Accepting the competition rules is a requirement to participate in the competition.
8. Delivery: The prizes will be delivered at the Closing ceremony.
