## **GRADES FOR THE ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS APPROVED IN MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE**

The committees can grant the following grades:

- **Pass**
- **Conditional pass**
- **Fail**
- **Not submitted**
- **Not assessable**

### **Pass:**

The academic committee may grade those doctoral students who meet the requirements established in the doctoral programme with a “pass”.

### **Conditional pass:**

The academic committee may grade those doctoral students who meet the requirements established in the doctoral programme, but who have to make some formal change in the research plan or in the annual self-report, with a “conditional pass”. In these cases, the doctoral student must correct the documents in accordance with the requirements and dates established by the committee.

### **Fail:**

When the doctoral student does not meet the requirements established in the doctoral programme, the academic committee may grade them with a “fail”. The doctoral student who does not pass the ordinary annual assessment may reapply for the second assessment. A second negative assessment implies being permanently removed from the programme.

### **Not submitted**

Should a doctoral student not submit the research plan or annual self-report, and/or the activities document, the academic committee may grade the person affected with a “not submitted”. They will have to submit the new research plan/self-report in the second assessment period.

If the assessment corresponding to the second period is positive, the doctoral student may formalize the registration for the following year. However, if the result is negative (fail) or not submitted, it shall be understood that they have two negative assessments and they shall be permanently removed from the programme.

### **Not assessable**

The doctoral student who has applied for temporary absence which has been accepted by the Committee will have to be graded as “not assessable”. Notwithstanding this, the academic committees may assess each case in particular and propose another grade, should they consider this to be appropriate.

The doctoral student who, in view of the start date of the doctorate, does not have to make a submission for the current assessment and does not make one, shall be graded with a “not assessable”. However, they must make a submission for the following assessment.
