



DEPOSIT AND DEFENSE OF THE THESIS

THESIS SUBMISSION AND PERIODS FOR THE DEFENSE

What should I do for the deposit and defense of my thesis?





When will I be able to defend my thesis?

You will be able to defend in approximately **two months** from the day you deliver the doctoral thesis

WHY TWO MONTHS? The answer is in this link.

1) 10 days – comprovation of the administrative requirements



2) The academic committee has a maximum period of 30 days to resolve



3) Once the deposit is authorized the thesis must be 10 days in public exposure



4) Between the first day of public exposure and the first possible day for the defense: must pass 30 days

ENROLLMENT

WHEN AND WHERE:

- The application form must be send with all the documents for the deposit of the thesis.
- When the thesis is approved by the academic committee.
- We will send you the enrollment by email and you have to pay online

DEADLINES AND FEES

The fees to be paid are linked to the academic year in which the thesis will be defended:

1) If you want to defend your thesis within the current academic year, all documentation must be submitted **before June 15**. Doctoral students who submit their thesis on this date must **defend before September 30**.

Fees: only the amount corresponding to the thesis defense

2) If the thesis is delivered between June 16 and September 30, the defense will be made in the following academic year.

Fees: the amount corresponding to the thesis defense, the learning support fee and the file management fee.

3) If the thesis is submitted from October 1, the defense will be made in the new course that begins on that date.

Fees: the amount corresponding to the thesis supervision, thesis defense, learning support fee and file management fee.
